- Participation in and sponsorship of Township recycling and clean-up programs
- Acquisition of additional public lands vital to the environmental well-being of the Township's residents



The CEAC was formed in 1990 to advise and assist the Township Board regarding environmental issues. In this role, the CEAC has:

- Supported the creation of the Saline River Greenway initiative
- Proposed the adoption of a local Wetland Ordinance
- Posted monthly tips on soil and water conservation for residents on the Township Website
- Posted Partners for Clean Streams Newsletters on the Township Website
- Co-sponsored 2007 York Township Earth Day
