

Over the past month or so the Sheriff's Dept has received several calls referring to the operations of ATVs and Motorcycles (Dirt Bikes) on several roads around the township. Several young people have been seen riding up and down the roads with more than one person on a vehicle and in several cases no helmets. The Law does not allow a person, being an adult or child, to ride such a vehicle on any road in the State of Michigan or York Township unless that vehicle is plated and has all the safety equipment for operation on the roadway. There have been several kids talked to in the past and this seems not to be working.

I have met with all the Deputies in York Township. It will be our policy that any vehicle that is found on the roadway and is illegal will be impounded and the driver of that vehicle will be ticketed. This is a great concern to me and I feel that this action is necessary to prevent a major tragedy from occurring. I'm writing this to all of the citizens of York Township in hopes that if you know anyone that is doing this to please pass this information onto them in hopes this will prevent an unnecessarily tragedy from occurring and to prevent any one from getting hurt.
