PURPOSE:

To establish a procedure for requesting a BURN PERMIT within the boundaries of the Charter Township of York for the residents of both the Milan Area Fire Department and Saline Area Fire Department service areas.

SCOPE:

To be followed by all Township residents in order to ensure proper authority to burn within the legal jurisdiction of the Milan and Saline Area Fire Department Districts, also known as the response area(s).

The above numbers reach the Communications Center for the appropriate Fire Departments. The dispatcher will take all pertinent information including: type of requested burning to be done and size within the guidelines of the York Township Open Burning Ordinance No. 110 effective March 23, 2006.
