RESOLUTION TO ADOPT ORDINANCE NO. 152  
AMENDMENT TO TRUCK ROUTES**

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the Township Board of the Charter Township of York, Washtenaw County, Michigan held at the Township Hall in said Township, on the 10th day of July, 2018, at 7:30 p.m.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member Helen Neill and seconded by Member Chuck Tellas.

**WHEREAS**, the Charter Township of York Board desires to add Moon Road from Bemis to Willis Road and Willis Road from Moon Road to the City of Saline city limits as additional designated routes for truck traffic through the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Attorney prepared a proposed ordinance to amend the Township's Truck Route Ordinance, Ordinance No. 75, as amended, for the purpose of including the additional portions of Moon and Willis Roads as additional designated truck routes in the Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed ordinance was given No. 152, introduced for first reading at this Board's regular meeting on June 12, 2018, and then published in the form it was introduced, all in compliance with the requirements of Section 20 of the Charter Township Act, PA 359 of 1947, being MCL 42.20;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the York Charter Township Board of Trustees hereby adopts Ordinance No. 152, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, and directs the Township Clerk to publish the Ordinance in accordance with law and take such other action as is necessary to make the ordinance effective.

**ORDINANCE No. 152**

**EFFECTIVE DATE: JULY 19, 2018**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE YORK CHARTER TOWNSHIP TRUCK ROUTE ORDINANCE, BEING ORDINANCE No. 75, PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY IN ARTICLE VII, SECTION 29, MICHIGAN CONSTITUTION OF 1963, AND SECTION 726 OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, BEING MCL§257.726, AND TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND GENERAL WELFARE UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF PUBLIC ACT 359 OF 1947, AS AMENDED, TO REPEAL ANY ORDINANCE OR PROVISION THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith, AND TO PRESCRIBED PENALTIES AND ENFORCEMENT REMEDIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.**

**THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF YORK WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:**

**Section 1. PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to amend The York Charter Township Truck Route Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 75, by permitting additional commercial truck routes within the Township as provided for herein.

**Section 2. AMENDMENTS, ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS.** Section 4, Commercial Truck Routes within York Charter Township, of the York Charter Township Truck Route Ordinance is deleted and replaced with the following:

**Section 4. COMMERCIAL TRUCK ROUTES WITHIN YORK CHARTER TOWNSHIP.**

The following roads in the Township, to the exclusion of all other roads, are hereby designated as commercial truck routes:

1. US-23;
2. Carpenter Road;
3. Stony Creek Road;
4. Milan-Oakville Road;
5. Willis Road between Carpenter and Platt Road;
6. Dennison Road to the County Line;
7. Platt Road North of Willis;

8. Arkona East of US-23;
9. Saline-Milan Road to Mooreville Road, Mooreville Road to City limits of Milan;
10. Bemis Road, city limits of Saline to Carpenter Road;
11. Moon Road from Bemis to Willis Road; and
12. Willis Road from Moon Road to the City of Saline city limits.

The commercial truck routes are shown on attached Exhibit A.

**Section 3. PENALTY.** A person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a civil infraction, and upon a conviction thereof, shall be assessed a civil fine of not less than \$250.00 and not more than \$500.00, plus costs, damages, expenses, and other sanctions allowed by law.

**Section 4. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES REPEALED.** Except as otherwise provided for herein, the remainder of Ordinance No. 75 is affirmed and continued in full force. Ordinance No. 144 is hereby repealed. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are also hereby repealed.

**Section 5. SAVING CLAUSE.** Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinances hereby repealed.

**Section 6. SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or subsection is declared void or inoperable for any reason by any court, it shall not affect any other part or portion hereof other than the part declared void or inoperable.

**Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE; PUBLICATION.** The Township Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published in the manner required by law. This Ordinance shall be effective as of the date of final publication of the Ordinance.

This Ordinance was duly adopted by the York Charter Township Board at its regular meeting called and held on the 10th day of July, 2018, and was ordered given publication in the manner required by law.

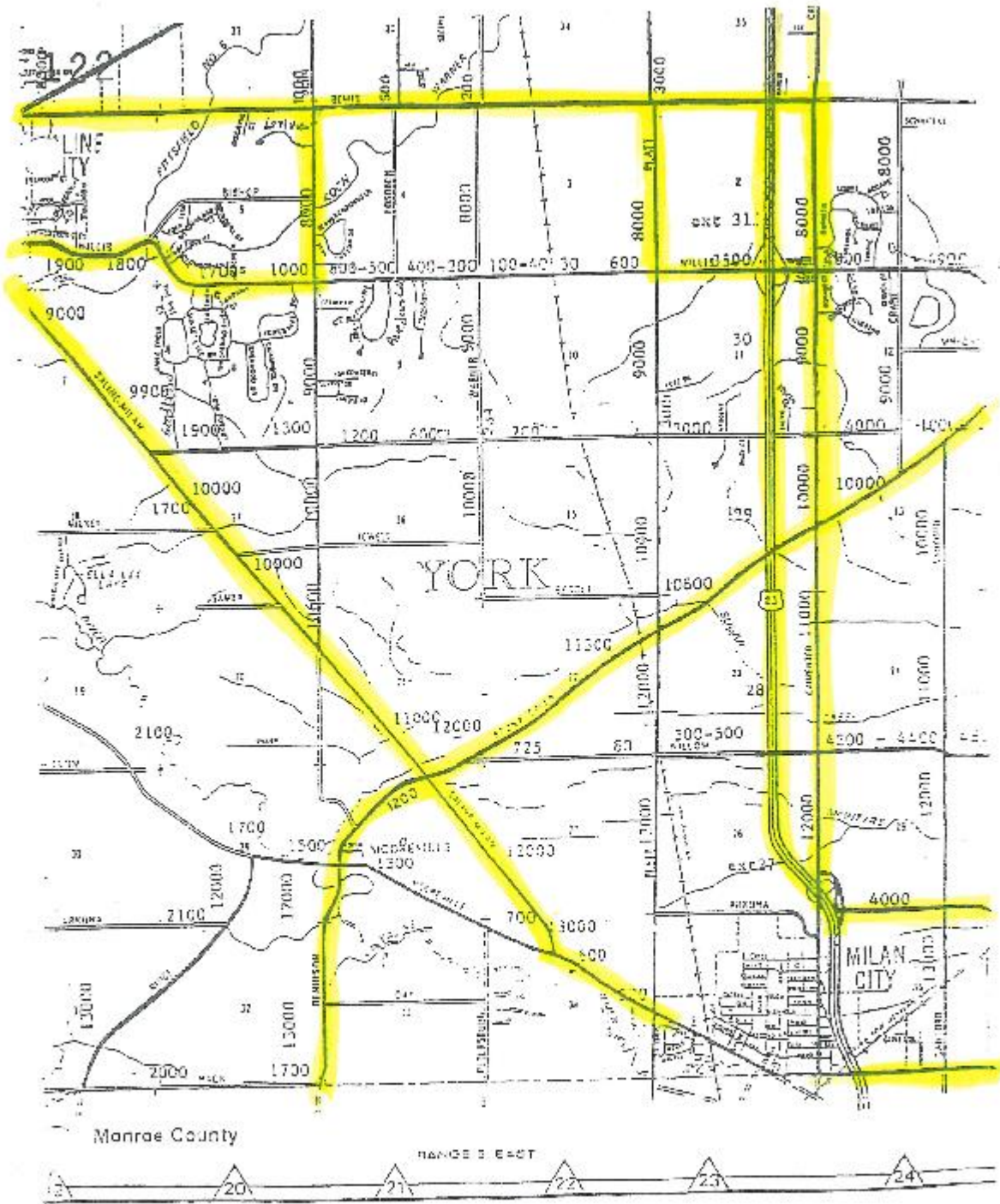
